Once it has adjusted to its' new surroundings, your cat should be kept inside at night for its own safety and the safety of the local wildlife.
- We have a 28 day cooling off period whereby any cat purchased can be returned to the refuge within 28 days. At the discretion of the refuge, no refund is given but a credit for another animal is allowable within 6 months. This is a once only option.
- Ownership of the cat/kitten does not transfer to you until you have complied with the SCARS Conditions of Sale and signing this form, you agree to our Terms and Conditions of Sale.
